Order

WHEREAS, in terms of section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 Jai Bharti College of Education, Jai Bharti Complex, Loharin, P.O.-Khiah, Dist. Hamirpur-177020, Himachal Pradesh had submitted an application to the Northern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for seeking permission for D.El.Ed. Course of two year duration for an intake of 50 (Fifty only) students on 30.10.2009.

AND WHEREAS, deficiency letter was issued to the institution on 06.01.2010 and the reply dated 02.02.2010 received from the institution in response to the deficiency letter was considered by NRC in its 156th meeting held from February 22-23, 2010 and it was decided to close file related to D.El.Ed. Course. Accordingly, the application of the institution was closed vide NRC order No. F.NRC/NCTE/NRCAPP240/156th meeting/2010/18685-18686 dated 18.03.2010 on the following points:

- The building plan is not approved by competent authority.

AND WHEREAS, the institution thereafter, preferred an appeal dated 07.04.2010 before the Council (NCTE), New Delhi against the aforesaid order. The Council vide order dated 14.05.2010 accepted the appeal and set aside NRC's order dated 18.03.2010 and remand back the case to NRC for further processing on merit.

AND WHEREAS, in compliance of the appeal order, the case was considered by NRC in its Emergent Meeting held on 19th July, 2010 and it was decided that Visiting Team may be sent for inspection. Accordingly, the inspection of the institution was conducted on 30.10.2010.

AND WHEREAS, the institution had filed a petition No. 654/2011 before the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh against the NRC, the court had passed an order dated 03.03.2011 in which the Court directed to consider the case of the institution in the next meeting of the NRC.


AND WHEREAS, in compliance of Court order, the case was considered by NRC in its 180th meeting, and it was decided that the letter of intent prior to recognition under clause 7(9) of NCTE Regulation, 2009 be issued to the institution. As per decision of NRC, letter dated 27.06.2011 was issued to the institution.

AND WHEREAS, the reply received from the institution in response to the letter dated 27.06.2011 was considered by NRC in its 188th meeting held from November 11-15, 2011 and it was decided that a clarification be sought from the institution on the following point before considering the case for 7(11) of NCTE Regulations, 2009.

- Duplicate FDRs of Rs. 5.00 lakhs as Endowment Fund and Rs. 3.00 lakhs as Reserve Fund converted into joint account be submitted for further processing.

AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh has passed an order dated 23.11.2011 which is reproduced below:

".....Within a day of production of the fixed deposit in joint name of the petitioner and the NCTE, the petitioner shall be granted the recognition. The petitioner may produce the recognition from the NCTE before the H.P. Board of School Education, Dharamshalala and from that day onwards, the petitioner shall also be participated in the counseling, since on such recognition, the affiliation is to be granted....."

AND WHEREAS, the institution vide letter dated 26.11.2011 submitted the required FDRs in compliance of the direction of Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh dated 23.11.2011 that "within a day of production of the fixed deposit in joint name of the petitioner and the NCTE, the petitioner shall be granted recognition".

AND WHEREAS, in compliance of the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Himachal Pradesh in the CWP No.- 8179 of 2011, the Northern Regional Committee noted in its 189th Meeting, emergently, that the Institution vide its letter dated 26.11.2011 received on 28.11.2011 has submitted the required FDRs of Rs. 8 Lakh towards Endowment Fund & Reserve Fund converted into joint account with the RD, NRC, NCTE. As per provision of the NCTE Act, Rules & Regulations, the original file of the Institution, VTR, reply submitted by the Institution from time to time viz-a-viz provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines issued by the NCTE Hqr. from time to time including letter No. 49-6/2011/NCTE/N&S dated 11th August, 2011 have been considered by the Northern Regional Committee (NRC). The reply of the Institution in compliance of Letter of Intent, prior to recognition, under clause 7(9) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009 is in order. Hence, the NRC decides that an order for formal recognition under clause 7(11) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009 be issued to the Institution keeping in view the direction of the Hon'ble High Court dated 23.11.2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Northern Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to **Jai Bharti College of Education, Jai Bharti Complex, Loharin, P.O.-Khiah, Dist. Hamirpur-177020, Himachal Pradesh** for conducting **D.El.Ed. Course** of two years duration for an intake of 50 (Fifty only) students w.e.f. dated 28.11.2011 under clause 7(11) of NCTE Regulations subject to the following conditions:

- I. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- II. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(12) of the NCTE Regulations, 2009.

Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed under relevant norms and standards of NCTE for other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc, wherever applicable.

The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year alongwith the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant together with statement of T.D.S. in respect of the salary paid to the staff.

The institution shall maintain & update its Web-site as per provisions of NCTE Regulations and always display following as mandatory disclosure: -

- Copy of the Application Form
- Land and Building Particulars
- Staff Profile
- Recognition letter
- Information for having fulfilled the norms & standard and other required conditions.

In case if the land is in the name of the Society/Trust, the Society/Trust must transfer the land within six month in the name of the institution failing to which action shall be initiated to withdraw the recognition. It shall be essential on the part of the institution concerned to get the needful done in this regard and intimate the respective Regional Committee along with the new land document within the stipulated time.

If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued, there under, the Regional Committee shall withdraw the recognition as stipulated provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act 1993
